#### **Objectives for the academic year 2021-22**

#### • To deliver curriculum efficiently with the help of online platform

The objective relates to the mission of providing quality education in a facilitative, challenging and positive environment. This objective is an ongoing process as due to uncertain situations like pandemics the students were to be tutored individually at their homes. So, to deliver curriculum effectively the teachers will be trained. The school believes that each child is unique and grooming them is very essential. The teachers will be trained to use the digital platform effectively

#### • To train teachers to prepare a blended learning plan by integrating digital tools

The objective is related to the mission of providing quality education in a facilitative and challenging environment. During the pandemics the online platform is the only accessible platform to deliver the curriculum. The teachers will be trained to prepare blended lesson plans and use various digital tools available to make the learning effective and interesting.

# • To incorporate various opportunities for faculty development by focusing on one subject every year

The objective relates to enhance the academic and intellectual environment in the Institution by providing faculty members with enough opportunities to train themselves in various aspects like teaching learning process, designing innovative activities, designing assessment for diverse needs.

#### • To train teachers in online evaluation process

During the pandemics the online platform was the only accessible platform to deliver the curriculum so assessment of the same was also an important aspect. The teachers were acquainted with the various assessment tools to be used effectively to complement the teaching learning process.

#### • To integrate Art with education



#### **Infrastructure Details**

• Smart class rooms with Wi-Fi campus - City Pride School has state of art classrooms equipped with LCD projectors and Computers in each class. The entire school is Wi-fi connected with internet connectivity available even in the classrooms .Teachers regularly use Computers for teaching, learning and evaluation process. The school has implemented ERP system for effective learning management system

The school has installed CCTV camera on all the school gates and also GPS systems in school bus for security.



• **Computer Labs**- To keep pace with advanced technology and to use computers as an application tool a computer lab is available with internet connectivity. About 40 computers are installed in the lab and it is well maintained time to time. There is a system administrator to take care of the requirements and efficient teachers are appointed to deliver the content to the students.





**Robotics Lab** - The school has established a state of art Robotics lab in association with ThinkLabs from IIT Mumbai. The training will be conducted for the selected students of STD: 6 & 7.



• Fashion Design lab- A Fashion Designing Lab is set up for the academic year 2021-22 where the selected students of STD:VI and VII will be trained for basic stitching skills.eativity Lab - We at school are introducing experiential learning program which revolves round STEAM - skills of Science Technology, Engineering, Art and Mathematics. These skills help in developing problem solving and critical analysis and prepare students to think out of box so that students can apply knowledge to solve real life problems. A special lab with manipulates has been made available for children wherein they



design different structures. Students work in groups and do their presentations.



• Library - The school has a well-stocked library with about 3500 books on various topics, magazines, reference books, CD collections for teachers and students.





• Maths Lab- To explore mathematical concepts in practical manner and create visual impact of



mathematical concepts, the school has developed a well-equipped maths lab where students of class I-VI can visit regularly and learn maths enthusiastically.

• Science Lab & Discovery Lab - School has established three science labs which stimulate the need of students to know how things work. Along with this school has developed "Discovery lab" with guidance from Gakken Science Academy Japan. These labs develop little scientists and help to teach scientific principles in the most amazing way.




• Medical room- The school has a well-equipped medical room for first aid treatment. A nurse is appointed for treating medical emergencies and the school is connected to a nearby super specialty hospital.





- Activity room- An activity room, well equipped with toys ,Educomp smart class, is available for preprimary students.
- School Auditorium School functions and parents meetings are conducted in the school auditorium that has a seating capacity of about 200 people.





• **Sports Ground**- The school has an in-campus play ground to bring out the sporting talent of children and inculcate spirit of sportsmanship. In order to increase the nature connectivity, a separate sports and games ground has been developed in the adjacent plot so that students will be familiar playing in such natural geographical features too.







#### **Online Education**

The academic year 2021 - 2022, again faced a very challenging time which brought the world to a complete halt with the Corona pandemic and with lockdown all over the Nation. This isolation was unique and unprecedented event in our lives. It had become imperative to stay at home and we had to decide as to how meaningfully we could utilize our time. In these hard times, we had to maintain positivity and high morale.

In the month of May 2021 the school decided to conduct online sessions for Summer Camp Activities. To do so the Management thought of the right option of software to be used. We already had Microsoft license. So taking into consideration Cyber Security, cyber safety and the learning management system provided by Microsoft we decided to use **Microsoft Teams**.

Teams were created for all the students and teachers of the whole school as per the choice given by the students for the Summer Camp Activity. Teams were made activity wise.. This enabled the teachers, students and parents to have an idea about the details of the activities.

In response to all the challenges faced, we continued the use of technology for effective teachinglearning to happen. Our official teaching platform 'MS Teams' was of great help. City Pride School had opted MS Teams for real time online teaching initially in 2020-2. We have decided to post the prerecorded sessions which include PPT's, videos, audios etc. through MS Teams so that the teaching did not stop. To teach remotely, a classroom without students was a huge challenge for a teacher. This situation helped in inculcating the habit of "Self Study" in students. As per the plan, we began our new academic session from 1<sup>st</sup> April 2021.

Training sessions were conducted for MS Teams by Dr. Deepali Sawai Madam with the help of Mrs. Amruta Dike, Mrs. Aafreen Usmani and Mrs. Rupali Gawarle. Teachers were also given training for Teams by Socrates Foundation [Mrs.Charu Mathur and Mrs.Shefali] for using the various online teaching tools. Videos, messages and PPTs were sent timely to the teachers as a helping material.



As per our daily routine, we would begin our sessions with meditation audio every day.

Coming to the academics section, we had already sent the text book images of few lessons, for all subjects of Std. I to Std. VI. Teachers uploaded the study material of two subjects daily for Std. I to VI on Teams. This material would be sent on the previous day by late evening so that on the next day the students could start their studies on time. This study material included PPTs, videos, audios which were sent to the students in parts, explaining the first unit or lesson part by part. Every subject was repeated twice a week. This was followed by notes, question-answers, worksheets, home assignments, activity sheets etc.

"All work and no play makes jack a dull boy" so after study time, students were asked to remain engaged in household activities, reading books, making art/craft articles and also in doing physical exercises like yoga/asanas at home. As our usual practice, we also sent some inspirational videos in between upon which parents could you have good discussions with their children.

Our teachers not only covered the scholastic areas but also the co-scholastic areas like dance/

music/art. Our physical instructors kept students occupied by sending them videos on health and fitness and easy exercises that could be done at home.

Our students have responded well to online classes and have been getting their doubts cleared. Since the parents were kept in the loop from time to time, through mails and messages they were well aware of what the school is trying to do to cope up with this change.

City Pride School continued the ONLINE LIVE SESSIONS with a blend of synchronous and asynchronous mode of teaching. With a balanced structure of online live sessions we were able to cater to the needs of students and parents. A good combination of scholastic and co-scholastic activities kept the teaching learning process moving ahead.



#### • <u>Readiness for online session</u>

• The school again conducted a survey in 2021 to understand the availability of resources to assess the readiness for online sessions. As an awareness was created amongst the parents and the students in 2020-21, they were ready with the equipments and the platform required for smooth delivery of curriculum. The school has created login credentials for all students again using a different domain, i.e.cityprideschoolmoshi.org and these credentials were provided through Top School, mail id, WhatsApp to all the students so that they get access to the online platform easily.

#### • <u>Commencement of Online session:</u>

A timetable was prepared to conduct the Teaching learning process smoothly. Taking into consideration the power cut in our area ,the timetable was prepared in such a manner that Saturday and Sunday was an Off day . The school started with the online sessions in the month of June.

#### • <u>Attendance:</u>

98–99 % students attend the online sessions. Only 1-2% students who were not able to attend the online session due to network issue or some medical reasons were supported through offline medium. It was in the form of Videos prepared by the teachers and uploaded on You tube or sent through google drive. The link of the same was provided to the students .They were also provided with hard copies of textbooks as and when lockdown was lifted in their area. Links of the textbook were provided . Regular meetings were conducted with the parents to understand the effectiveness of online teaching learning process.

#### <u>Assessment of Learning gaps:</u>

During online session verbal assessment by asking questions was conducted by the teachers . . The various tests assigned in the form of Google forms gave an analysis of the performance of the class and question wise mapping . The teacher was able to map the learning gaps. Weekly test and activities were conducted to monitor the teaching learning process . The periodic test



was conducted online to assess whether the learning objectives are achieved or not. Question wise feedback was provided to the students during periodic test .Virtual interactions were conducted to understand the learning gaps from the feedback given by the parents.

#### • <u>Remedial Measures taken by school :</u>

Doubt solving sessions were arranged by the teachers for the students. To fill the learning gaps especially observed in the subject of Mathematics Reformative class was conducted after the regular sessions for std III to VI. The teacher after mapping the learning gaps reinforced the concepts. Different activities were conducted to make the teaching learning process joyful. A timely feedback was provided to the parents through online sessions and whatsApp so that collaboratively the teaching learning process went on smoothly.

#### **Offline Education**

#### **Re-opening of School**

City Pride School has built a platform of trust and has been open for free exchange of views from all our parents in time of crucial decision making. We appreciate the suggestions and perspectives shared by our parents! The decision to open the school was based on the directives from the Government. Students coming to school were a welcoming move considering that our students were away from school campus for past 18 months. Almost 94 % parents were willing to send their child to school for Offline classes in January. Considering all the realities of this age group, we had decided upon the following plan (Hybrid Model).

#### **Offline Mode**

After a break City pride school planned to start regular full day school for all the students from Monday 14th February 2022. The school started running from Monday to Friday. Saturday was a holiday. School was running in both online/offline modes simultaneously. As per the situation scenario time table was set. For Offline School student's school timings were :

Std I to VI - 8.15 am to 12.50 pm.

#### SAFETY NORMS

• Parents were requested to send the child with proper mask, sanitizer bottle, napkin for personal use.

• The child had instructed to avoid sharing these items with others.

• Parents were instructed to not to send child school in case the child is sick or anyone in the family is sick.



• Thermal checking used to happen at the entry for local students and for bus students it used to happen before they board the bus.

#### **Online Mode**

In order to cater to the students, who have opted to stay home and not attend Offline School, we had live streamed sessions as per their timings mentioned above, on all 5 days (Monday to Friday).

The major focus during Offline classes was on understanding the learning gaps and working accordingly on all core subjects. This model was continued till the closure of the academic year.



#### **Evaluation Pattern (Diagnostic Test)**

The children had been learning Online for the last 2 years. This was a universal fact and we all had embraced the new teaching learning mode with open arms.

Though we did our best and used the best of teaching strategies in Online school, we all knew that learning gaps are bound to happen.

As Educators we could foresee:

- Students had lost the habit of writing examinations.
- Fear/anxiety for exams/tests.
- They had lost the sense of time management.
- The writing speed was slow.
- Reading and Comprehension skills were affected
- Loss of habit of memorization
- Structured writing / Drawing skills were affected
- Computation skills /quick calculation habit was lost

Though these learning gaps were different for each grade, it needed to be diagnosed. Hence, the Final Examination was Diagnostic in nature. Diagnostic Test was conducted to test the basic concepts required for the next level and was not based on information/facts. It was an assessment based on which we were able to identify learning gaps (grade wise). In order to get the true picture, we requested parents to send students to school for examination.

Once the gaps get identified, we could create a Plan of Action for the month of April when new academic year begins.

We were also aware that a few parents would not be apprehensive to send their wards to school due to Corona situation. We also explained them to take stock of the situation in March and to send their child for an Offline Examination for two hours. Another possibility was that the child insisted on doing Online Exam due to anxiety /fear of exams, in such a case parents were requested to talk to their children and instill confidence and give unconditional support to overcome this fear.



For those parents who still feel their child will not come for Offline Examination, we had the provision for Online Exams for them.

This is how City Pride School planned a customized approach for its students in the upcoming year,

so that NO child is left behind. We successfully conducted the diagnostic test at school level.

This Final Examination was treated as an "ASSESSMENT FOR LEARNING – the Learning Gaps", which can be addressed in the upcoming session. City Pride School always has a thoughtful approach in all its actions and decisions. An outside agency also conducted ASSET Diagnostic Test in the month of April for Std 3 to 7.

The test was conducted for English, Mathematics and Science subjects. A detailed child specific analysis report will be shared with the parents in the month of June. # **Education at CPS**

#### • Activity Based Education:

Education at City Pride School is based on project approach with exposure through field visits, research projects, science workshops and presentations. The Continuous and comprehensive evaluation pattern [C.C.E.] is followed meticulously in the school.
