Infrastructure Details

- **Smart class rooms with Wi-Fi campus** - City Pride School has state of art classrooms equipped with LCD projectors and Computers in each class. The entire school is Wi-fi connected with internet connectivity available even in the classrooms .Teachers regularly use Computers for teaching, learning and evaluation process. The school has implemented ERP system for effective learning management system

The school has installed CCTV camera on all the school gates and also GPS systems in school bus for security.

- **Computer Labs-** To keep pace with advanced technology and to use computers as an application tool a computer lab is available with internet connectivity. About 40 computers are installed in the lab and it is well maintained time to time. There is a system administrator to take care of the requirements and efficient teachers are appointed to deliver the content to the



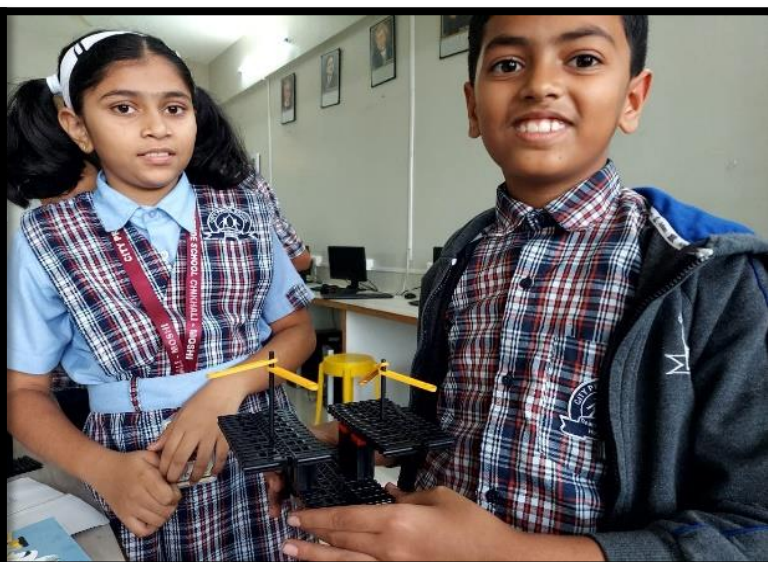
- **Robotics Lab** - The school has established a state of art Robotics lab in association with ThinkLabs from IIT Mumbai. The training will be conducted for the selected students of STD :6 & 7.



- **Fashion Design lab-** A Fashion Designing Lab is set up for the academic year 2021-22 where the selected students of STD:VI and VII will be trained for basic stitching skills.



- Creativity Lab** - We at school are introducing experiential learning program which revolves round STEAM - skills of Science Technology, Engineering, Art and Mathematics. These skills help in developing problem solving and critical analysis and prepare students to think out of box so that students can apply knowledge to solve real life problems. A special lab with manipulates has been made available for children wherein they design different structures. Students work in groups and do their presentations.



- Library** - The school has two well stocked libraries with about 3500 books on various topics, magazines, reference books, CD collections for teachers and students.





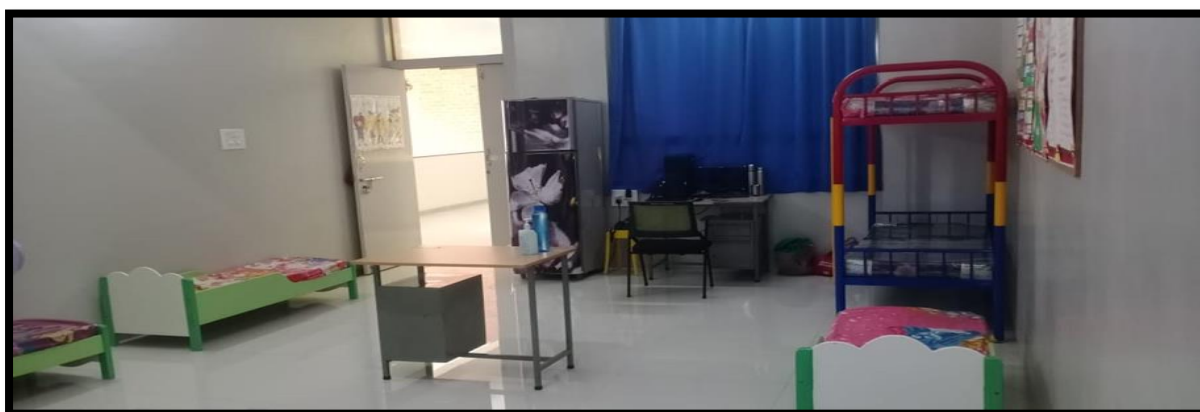
- **Maths Lab-** To explore mathematical concepts in practical manner and create visual impact of mathematical concepts, the school has developed a well-equipped maths lab where students of class I-VII can visit regularly and learn Maths enthusiastically.



- **Science Lab & Discovery Lab** - School has established three science labs which stimulate the need of students to know how things work. Along with this school has developed “Discovery lab” with guidance from Gakken Science Academy Japan. These labs develop little scientists and help to teach scientific principles in the most amazing way.



- **Medical room-** The school has a well-equipped medical room for first aid treatment. A nurse is appointed for treating medical emergencies and the school is connected to a nearby super specialty hospital.





- **School Auditorium** - School functions and parents meetings are conducted in the school auditorium that has a seating capacity of about 200 people.



- **Sports Ground**- The school has an in-campus play ground to bring out the sporting talent of children and inculcate spirit of sportsmanship. In order to increase the nature connectivity, a separate sports and games ground has been developed in the adjacent plot so that students will be familiar playing in such natural geographical features too.

Assessment of Learning gaps:

During the session verbal assessment by asking questions was conducted by the teachers . . The various tests assigned gave an analysis of the performance of the class and question wise mapping . The teacher was able to map the learning gaps. Weekly test and activities were conducted to monitor the teaching learning process . The periodic test was conducted to assess whether the learning objectives are achieved or not. Question wise feedback was provided to the students during periodic test .Virtual interactions were conducted to understand the learning gaps from the feedback given by the parents.

As it was the first year after the lock down students were worried about the 80 marks paper. They had a fear of studying the vast topic before the half yearly and yearly exam. So question banks were provided for all the subjects before both half yearly and yearly exam so that the students have a fair idea about the mode of study. This definitely helped the parents and students to complete the work in time. And they also came to know the variety of questions that can be asked in different ways with different weight age.

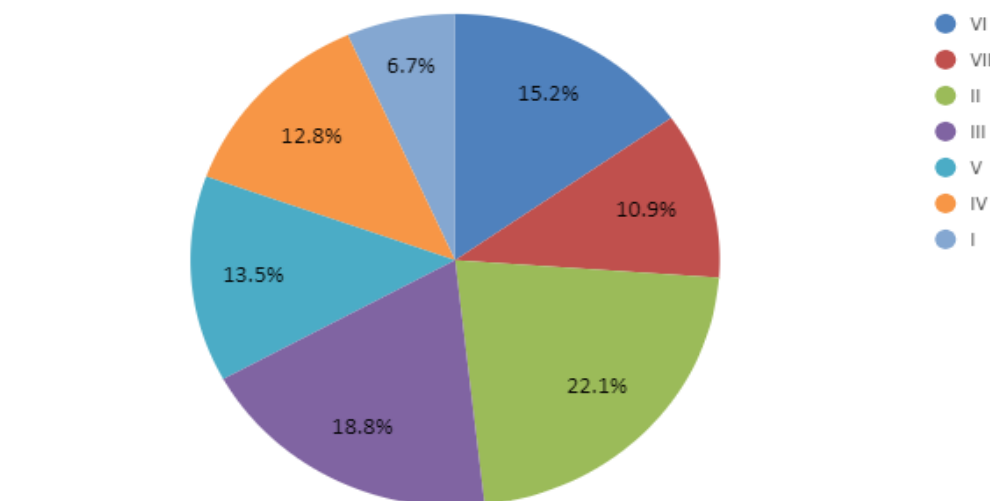
- **Remedial Measures taken by school :**

Doubt solving sessions were arranged by the teachers for the students. To fill the learning gaps especially observed in the subject of Mathematics Reformative class was conducted after the regular sessions for std III to VI .The teacher after mapping the learning gaps reinforced the concepts. Different activities were conducted to make the teaching learning process joyful. A timely feedback was provided to the parents through online sessions and whatsApp so that collaboratively the teaching learning process went on smoothly.

Education at CPS

- **Activity Based Education:**

Education at City Pride School is based on project approach with exposure through field visits, research projects, science workshops and presentations. The Continuous and comprehensive evaluation pattern [C.C.E.] is followed meticulously in the school.

The education system in our school aims at helping students in understanding the facts by working hands-on, applying simpler & investigative learning way so as to arouse interest & develop better understanding in their subject. The newly set up discovery science lab on the principles of GAKKEN education system in Japan is an appropriate example of learning science through nature.

- **Skill Development Approach**

From standard 6th onwards the school provides soft skill training to students to enhance their creativity, innovation, thinking, and problem-solving, communication skills, social & emotional learning along with essential life skills for building their confidence and leadership skills. The innovative programs make the children ready for 'out-of box' thinking and also helps in developing their all-round personalities.

We also work on social development of our children by engaging them in practical activities done for society. The encouragement by the school and the enthusiasm by the students is a perfect combination which helps students to explore and express themselves and to realize the real life situations. The various activities done by the school for the same are:

- **Donation**

ATSS trust running City Pride School, IICMR and ATSS College in PCMC extended a helping hand to the flood affected people of Konkan. Under this, essential items worth Rs. 4 lakhs, groceries, sheets, blankets, mats, etc. were distributed to about 500 families. Expressing his feelings about this, the founder of the organization, Shri M. D. Jambhekar said that by helping our countrymen in times of calamity, we have tried to maintain social commitment

Cultural Activities

With our vision to develop enlightened citizens, the school gives special emphasis on developing cultural and creative instincts among our children. On a regular basis, through the daily assembly significance of the day is mentioned to help them improve their knowledge.

Ashadi Ekadashi:- The celebration started by explaining the significance of the festival in which what is the meaning of “Aashadhi Ekadashi” and why it is being celebrated was informed to the students. The children came in saint attire and told glory to the children about respective saint. The children from 6th and 7th class came in Warkari attire and told glory about “**Lord Vitthala**” after this “Palakhi Procession” has conducted in entire school. In front of Palakhi traditional folk dance were played like fugadi, ringan etc played.





Bakri-Id:- The celebration is done during assembly for std 2 to 7 at 8.30 a.m. and for std 1 at 9.30 a.m. in auditorium. Green colour dress code is followed by the students and teachers for the celebration. The significance of Bakrid is spoken by Shiza Inamdar & Aaira Sabir for std 2-7 as well as for std 1 respectively. Students came to understand the importance of Bakrid and why it is being celebrated. The message of sacrifice is conveyed to the students deeply through this Bakrid celebration.

Nag Panchami:-The celebration started by explaining the significance of the festival in which what is the meaning of “Nag Panchami” and why it is being celebrated was informed to the students. The children from 3rd to 7th were present there. Same has been done for standard 1 children in the auditorium by explaining the significance of the festival. Nag Panchami is a day of traditional worship of snakes observed by Hindus throughout India. The worship is offered on the fifth day of bright half of lunar month of Shravana (July/August). People visit the temple of Lord Shiva, snake pits and they worship the snakes. Devotees offer milk, sweets and flowers. This festival is to celebrate the day when Lord Krishna defeated Kaliya Nag.



Raksha Bandhan:-The celebration started by explaining the significance of the festival in which what is the meaning of “Raksha Bandhan” and why it is being celebrated was informed to the students. The children tie Rakhi to the Driver uncle, Watchman bhaiya and Dada's of school. We also take few of our children to Chikhali Police station to tie Rakhi to Policemen .



Janmashtami:-The Janmashtami celebration started by explaining the significance of the



festival in which what is the meaning of “Krishna Janmoutsav” and why it is being celebrated was informed to the students. The Few children from 2nd std came in Radha Krishna attire . The children from 6th has perfomed one Song “ Choti Choti Gaiyyan “and Std 3rd class Singing students has performed “ Hari Sunder Nand Mukunda” . Mukunda Mukunda Dance performnace has given by std 4, 5, 6 dance students. Janmashtami medley singing performance given by Music Teacher – Mrs. Divyyaa Singh.



Ganesh Chaturthi:- The aim of celebrating ganeshutsav was to make students understand the history of ganeshutsav and the importance of celebrating it. The students also participated in the idol making of lord Ganesha with the suitable material that is available at home. The students found creative ways to make Ganesh idol with the materials that were available to them at home and came up with excellent ideas and made beautiful Ganesh idols



The program started by showing the ppt to the students and explained how we celebrate Ganesh utsav, the history behind the celebration and why do we immerse lord Ganesha on the 11th day of the Ganesh utsav. There was also a short video which explained about the birth of lord Ganesha. Later students also made Ganesh idol using clay, leaves, utensils, lentils and various different materials that was available at home. On the occasion of Ganesh chaturthi we conducted drawing and colouring activity for students from 1st to 7th. There was an enthusiastic response from the students. 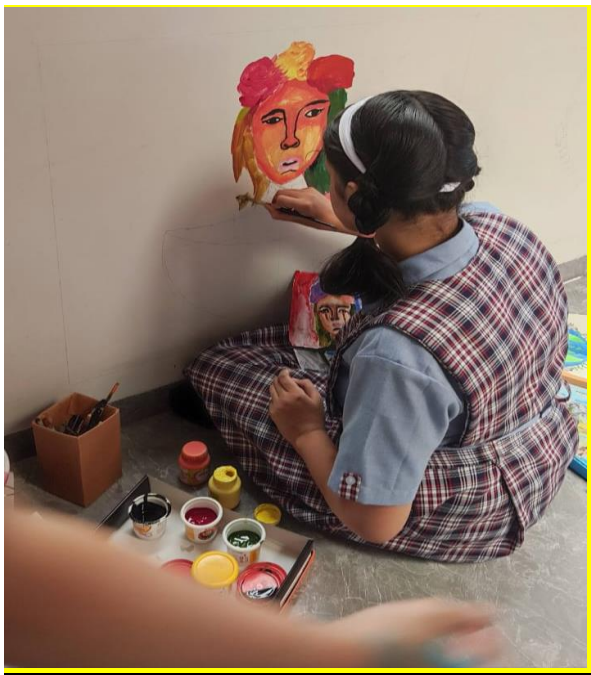
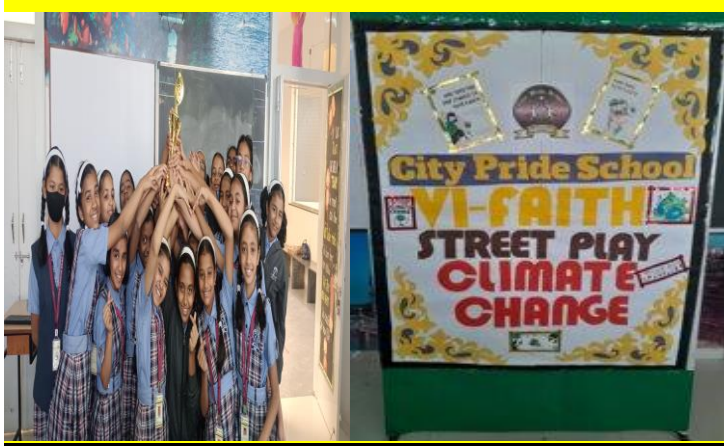


ART INTEGRATED ACTIVITIES

It is a cross-curricular approach to teaching and learning based on collaboration between the teaching of subject with the teaching of Art (Visual/performing etc.), where Art, in any of its multiple forms, becomes the primary pathway to learn the subject/topic and also of assessment. Art Integration is not a replacement for Art education. Integration happens only after students have been directly taught the Arts. Without this background knowledge, neither the students nor the subject teachers will be able to integrate art in education. For example, the notes in Hindustani Classical Music can be aligned with the teaching of Fractions in Mathematics. However, without the knowledge of music notes, it will be impossible for the students to comprehend the link between the two.

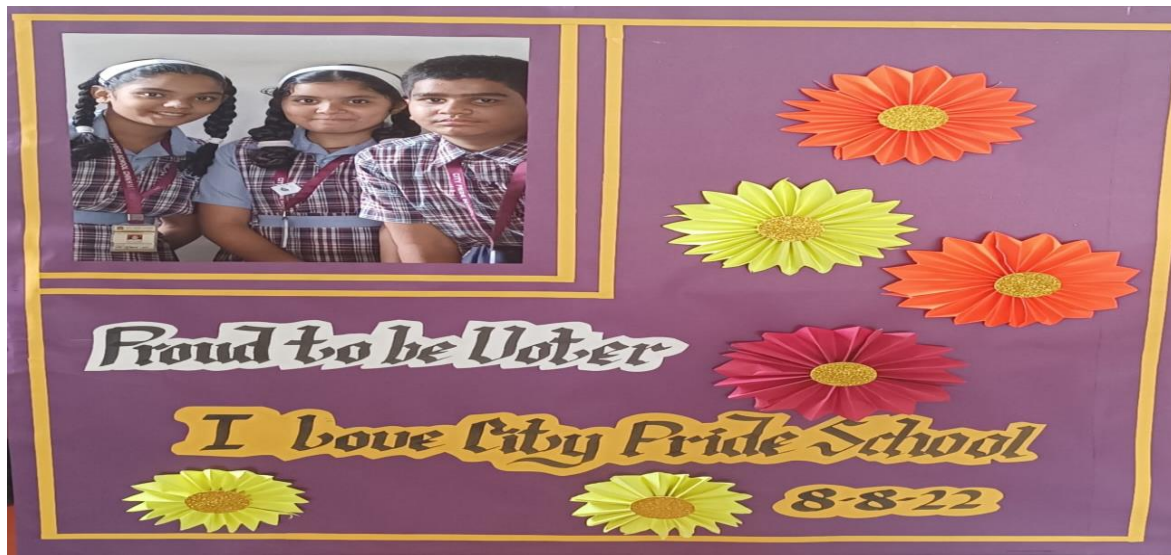
