II. SUPER ACHIEVER- CPS feels proud to share that Ved Khandekar student of City Pride School and Junior College gets Kishore Vaigyanic Protsahan Yojana (KVPY) scholarship, one of the most prestigious scholarship. This ensures his admission to IISER.

Kishore Vaigyanik Protsahan Yojana (English: Young Scientist Incentive Plan) (KVPY) is a scholarship program funded by the Department of Science and Technology of the Government of India, aimed at encouraging students to take up research careers in the areas of basic sciences.

III. HOMI BHABHA EXAM .- School Received "Best performing School Trophy" From STD:VI, 80 students appeared and 27 students qualified for level 2 exam. Out of that 4 students were selected for the third level. All four of them bagged silver medal in the third level.

STD:IX, out of 27 students 2 were selected for third level and one of them bagged gold medal and the other a silver.

City Pride is doing the best in this prestigious exam and has bagged the Vikram Sarabhai Trophy for best performing school in Pune for 3 years, 2015-16, 2017-18 and 2018-19.

- IV. ACHIEVEMENT IN GOVT.SCHOLARSHIP EXAM- City Pride School has the highest number of state rankers in prestigious Maharashtra state Government scholarship CBSE state Merit list with as many as five ranks holders rank 2, rank 3, rank 7, rank 8 in std 5 and rank 3rd in STD:8.
- V. ACHIEVEMENT IN IPM EXAM- From City Pride School Nigdi, we have 87 students who have cleared the first level of IPM exam in 2018-19. They will be appearing for the mega final in the month August 2019.
- VI. STD: XII INSPIRE SCHOLARSHIP- 21 students out of 80 appeared in the top one percentile of the H. Sc. Board result and are eligible for Inspire Scholarship instituted by Government of India.

 They get a scholarship of Rs.80,000 per year for five years if they take admission for pure science.

- (half yearly exam) :60 marks (date and syllabus will be given)
- So all these would appear on your report card out of 50 marksin each termwith grades.
- Grading for all Scholastic subjects will be done on an 8 point grading scale.
- Periodic Test -1 and Periodic Test -2 will be conducted out of 40 and the marks will be reduced to 10 and entered in the report card under the column of periodic test.
- Teachers will evaluate notebooks twice in a year and give marks keeping in mind following points. Criteria – Regularity in submission,
- Neatness in maintaining and writing (note book)
- Assignment completion Note book
- Maintenance of Note book

SUBJECT ENRICHMENT ACTIVITIES

- Subject specific activities will be carried out enhancing the understanding and skills
 of students. These activities will be carried out throughout the term, however the
 marks will be entered at the term ends (both half yearly and yearly)
- Under languages: Teachers will conduct activities to develop listening, speaking and reading skills, evaluate students using their own method and parameters. These skills could be evaluated over a period of time.
- Under Mathematical skill: Teachers will conduct activities testing their Mathematical skills and Math lab practical.
- Under Science: Practical work and activities conducted under various units will be marked.
- Projects could be Individual or group. So the entire scholastic areas will be graded on an 8 point grading scale.
- All the internal assessment + written work = 50 marks (per term)



 Now during open day we will show you the answer papers of your ward. Every subject would carry 20 marks weightage. This 20 marks will be reduced to 10 marks and entered during TERM in your report card under periodic test.




