Minutes of the Meeting

- 1) Welcome Note: Chairman, Mrs. Suja Rajesh welcomed all the EPTA members
- 2) Discussion:
 - a. <u>Previous MOM</u>: Teacher representative Shwetangna Prakash, read out the previous Minutes of the Meeting and all the members present confirmed it.
 - b. Admission Process:
 - Principal Suja Ma'am informed EPTA members about the ongoing Admission process.
 - The admission process for class LKG for the academic year 2022-23 is open and lucky draw will be done today live online in presence of Advisory and EPTA members, representatives from the education department (PCMC) and the local corporator Mrs. Ashwini Jadhav.
 - 43 students have got direct admission which includes siblings and Konkani Linguistic students. Remaining 77 students will be selected by lucky draw as per Govt. norms.
 - The selected students list will be available on school website <u>www.cityprideschool.com</u> at 4:00 pm today.
 - The annual academic fees for LKG would be Rs. 71500/- plus admission fee of Rs. 5000/-
 - For classes U.KG to STD 7th admission vacancy would be updated on the school website www.cityprideschool.com on 16th of January 2022.

- c. Suja Ma'am stated that hiring of new staff is under process. Written exams have been conducted and Demos are being conducted. City Pride School is very particular about hiring proficient and competent teachers and staff.
- d. Mrs. Madhuri Guttikonda parent representative for class 6 expressed her concern about the measures in case a child joins offline school even if he/she is sick. To which Suja Ma'am answered that it has been specified and given clear instructions to the parents via notices that any child suffering from cough, cold or fever should not come to offline school. We do thermal checking of all students and staff members at the school entrance itself and even send the child back home if we see any visible signs of sickness. Those children who have opted for online classes join the classes via live streaming and any child who falls sick will be added in live steaming.
- e. The batches are divided in such a way that all offline students get one day offline and one day online too. The subjects taught in online and offline classes are different. This step was taken because of the concern that students might not be able to sit the entire day with their masks on. So, the entire day schedule was divided in two parts to be followed in two days. STD 1st and 2nd don't have online classes.
- f. Dr. Sonal Kate asked inquired about the bus fare being for entire month as the students are using it on alternate days. She also asked if there would be any increase in the bus fee for the next academic session. To which Suja Ma'am replied that bus fare will be charged for the entire month even if the students will be using it on alternate days. And there would be no increase in the bus fare for the next academic session except for any abrupt increase in the fuel prices.
- g. Mr. Sachin Gholap asked if the school closes again will the bus fare which would be paid by the parents in advance be adjusted. To which Suja Ma'am replied that in such a situation arises the paid bus fee will be adjusted in the next academic session whenever the school reopens.
- h. Mr. Sadashiv Kotave asked about the number of breaks during offline school. To which Suja Ma'am replied that because the school is ending at 12:45 pm the break given is just one.
- Dr. Sonal Kate suggested that the school should collaborate with any hospital and give Flu vaccines to students with parent's consent. To which Suja Ma'am replied that the school will definitely consider the same.
- j. Teacher representative Shwetangna Prakash extended the vote of thanks and she stated that we could never compromise on the quality of education at City Pride School whether it is online or offline. We aspire to do our best for the students in all scenarios and we sincerely thank for all the help we get from the EPTA members in making the process smooth.

The meeting closed amicably at 11:30 am.
