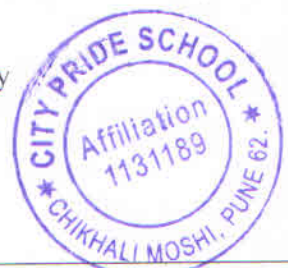
3) Discussion and sharing of thoughts -

- 4) Various measures have been taken by the school to ensure the health and safety and security of all the students in the school.
- 5) Transport facility has been provided to those students who have requested the same. We have a transport committee in place to take care of any issues that arise.
- 6) Mr Ravikumar Suryawanshi stated that there was some issue with the transport and he informed the transport committee and immediate action was taken by the transport committee and the issue was resolved immediately.
- 7) Breakfast facility is also provided by the school to students who wish to avail for the same. Management representative asked if there were any issues with the breakfast facility and all the EPTA members present in the meeting, whose wards avail the breakfast facility responded saying that breakfast committee works smoothly.
- 8) Management representative Ashwini Kulkarmi asked the parents about the feedback of the Question Bank provided by the school to the students as a help for the 'Half Yearly Examination'. To which Mrs. Pranali Raut replied that it has really helped the students to understand the various questions asked for a particular concept and was also used like a practice paper for the students.
- 9) Management representative Ashwini Kulkarmi further stated that CPS makes sure that in the month of March and April old concepts are revised and practiced again and introduction to new chapters begins only in the month of June and by the first exam students have a practice to write the paper faster and they also get a nack to understand the questions better.
- 10) Management representative Ashwini Kulkarmi further stated that during covid students immunity has gone low because the children have been protected and stayed at home all the while but now as schools have started students are getting good exposure to the outside world which is very important and one of the factors that will help to build their immunity.

Chairperson Mrs. Suja Rajesh shared the students attendance details which shows that from April 2022 to September 2022 students attendance is above 90% which is good but atleast 98% of attendance is expected and we have to work towards it . Ma'am, further added that it has been observed that the students who are habituated to remain absent are the once who are absent throughout and this pattern should change, students should be taught the importance of being punctual and attending school regularly. Before vacations too parents take leave in advance and leave without prior intimation which is setting a wrong example for the student and such leaves will not be granted.

- City Pride group of schools had organised "Kalamanch-The Dance Event" on 15th September 2022 at City Pride School, Moshi Campus. "Kalamanch" is a City Pride School initiative and it aims at promoting the talents in visual and performing art forms.
- **Ms. Phulawa Khamkar** an Indian choreographer and dancer, who works in Bollywood and Marathi films had graced the occasion as the Chief Guest.
- Dr. Ashwini Kulkarni stated that only 4 students are participating in the lantern making activity which is a very small number and the school expects more enrollments for such activities. Ma'am also stated that we need to check the reason for such poor response, she further stated that during covid students have lost all the discipline and that both parents should be equally involved in bringing up the child to the expected level.
- Dr. Ashwini Kulkarni further stated that at Nigdi branch they have initiated a drive: "Unplug to Restart" for students of std 5 to 10 where students will stop owning and using smart phones. Due to excess exposure to social media and use of technology there is a lot of disconnect between parents and children and together parents and school have to work to save our children from the irreversible damage and addiction.

• **Admission Process for the Academic Year 2023-24:**

- As per Govt. norms all the remaining applicants will be selected through a lucky draw. Admission process for UKG to Higher standards for the academic year 2023-2024 will start after 16 Jan 2023, in case of vacancy only. Baseline test will be conducted as per the vacancy status. Admissions will be granted on merit basis only. Admission notice will be published on the school website [www.cityprideschool.com] and the school notice board. Admission process for LKG for the academic year 2023-2024 will start in first week of December. Being a Konkani linguistic school, preference for LKG admissions will be given to Konkani linguistic students. Preference will be given to siblings and teacher's ward as well.

• **Staff recruitment for the academic year 2023-2024** will be done as per the need analysis of the school for teaching and non-teaching staff.

- Advertisement will be given in local newspaper for the same and it will be displayed on the school website as well.
- Interview, written exam and demo will be conducted accordingly for the shortlisted candidates.
- We pay good salaries to deserving candidates. We also give PF and fee concession to their ward.
- School is very particular about quality of teaching staff for academic excellence.
- Ashwini madam stated that when a new teacher joins the organization she should be given some time to understand the working culture of the organization and to adjust with the new environment. Immediately, parents should not start comparing the new teacher with old teachers but parents cooperation is of utmost importance and working together as a team will help the organization to grow.



• Fee Fixation 2023-24

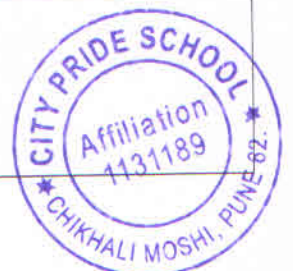
- AS PER MAHARASHTRA GOVT FEE REGULATION ACT-R NO MAHENG/2009/35528 DATED 26th Aug 2019 Page No 3
- (1A) The management of private unaided schools and permanently unaided schools may choose to declare at the time of admission to the students, the standard-wise fee structure for all the standards from first standard to the tenth standard. OR
- (1B) The management of private unaided schools and permanently unaided schools who does not choose to declare the fee structure as per the provisions under sub-section (1A) shall be eligible to propose the fees in the school which shall not be more than previous academic year fee plus an amount of fifteen percent of the said fee. Provided that, the private unaided schools and permanently unaided schools may increase the fees after two years from the date the fee approved by the Executive Committee.

OR

- (1C) The management of the school may increase the fee provided in the fee structure as mentioned in sub section (1A) or propose the fee higher than the rate as provided in sub-section (1B) or before two years as provided in the proviso to sub-section (1B), in unforeseen events, with the approval of 76 per cent of parents or approval of the Executive Committee by furnishing reasons or circumstances thereof.
- As per the above mentioned rule CITY PRIDE SCHOOL follows 1 A & 1B.
- The Chairperson Mrs. Suja Rajesh presented the fees structure from 2019 to 2022

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- Principal Mrs. Suja Rajesh informed the parents about the present fee structure of the school as follows:

- This above fees was applicable to all the students of the school for the academic year 2021-22 and 2022-23 .AS PER MAHARASHTRA GOVT FEE REGULATION ACT-R NO MAHENG/2009/35528 DATED 26th Aug 2019 Page No 3 – 1(B) school can increase the fee by 15%. But the school management has decided to increase the fees for the Academic year 2023-24 & 2024-25 by 12 % only. The school representative, Chairperson Suja Rajesh asked the EPTA members for the approval of the same.
- To which all the EPTA members approved for the new fee structure by raising their hand. **It was reaffirmed that the following fee structure will be followed for the academic year 2023-24 as well as 2024-25:**

- It was also informed to the EPTA that the next fee rise will be done for the academic year 2025-26 i.e. **after two years.**
