Minutes of the Meeting:

Point 1 | Welcome Note: Suja Madam welcomed all the E-PTA members and introduced the invitee Director of the school Dr. Ashwini Kulkarni by reading out her biodata.

Point 2] Confirmation of minutes of meeting: Teacher representative Mrs. Shwetangna Prakash read out the minutes of previous meeting of EPTA held on 20/7/2019. The member unanimously approved the minutes by raising hands.

Point number 3] Interaction with the Director: Dr. Ashwini Kulkarni thanked all the member for being the torch bearers of the school. She told about the importance of the role they play. She explained that the concept of the school board is based on the belief in the importance and power of shared leadership. Parents, faculty, administration and the community work together to provide advice regarding the policies of the school in accordance with the mission and vision of the school. The board members may offer their expertise and experience in strengthening the decision making process and hence play a very important role to deepen the bond between the parents and the school management.

The committee members Mrs. Shwetangna Prakash and Preeti Kanchangoudar appreciated the efforts taken by the school management during the period of heavy rains in Moshi area between 7th August 2019 and 17th August 2019. The road in front of the school was flooded and the management hence made the decision that the school bus will ply both the local and the bus students of City Pride till the water on the road in front of the school does not recede and this facility was provided for the local students free of cost. Extra bus was also provided to ply the local students. They also appreciated the fact that the difficulty of working parents was taken into consideration and that the management thought minutely of all the aspects.



Each and every member present applauded the management's decision and efforts taken to ensure the safety and security of the children by clapping hands.

The principal assured that the school days that were missed by the students due to heavy rains would be covered up by working on Saturdays in the month of August.

Point 4 | PTA Fund:

Principal informed the member that as per government norms Rs.50 is collected from each parent as PTA fund every year. This money is used for the welfare of school. After discussion between all the members following expense heads were earmarked for year 2019.

The members unanimously approved the above expense heads . the principal informed the members that a separate account is being opened for PTA fund which will be handled by the chairman of PTA

Point no 5 | Interaction with the members:

A] Mrs. Rima Nagu suggested that regular practice of hard words to be taken so that students are thorough with the words, to which the teachers present for the meeting replied that regular dictation is conducted in the class.

B] Mrs. Kiwi Soni suggested that the subject teachers should be added in the class groups so that if questions are directed from parents to the subject teachers they could easily answer the query of the concerned parents. To this principal replied that a particular subject teacher teaches across a no of classes and so she would have to be added to a number of groups which will get very difficult for the subject teacher as she will have to constantly keep replying to the messages of the parents. She also added that students should copy the home work form the blackboard as it helps in the hand and eye coordination and so H.W is not shared.

C] Mrs. Preeti K. said that more skill based activities should be included for the students. To this Shwetangna Prakash replied that we have age appropriate skill based activities like the discovery lab and the Art & Craft Lab for the students now from class 4 Creya lab will be introduced to the students and they have soft skills from class 6 onwards.

- D] Mrs. Preeti K. said that the students do not have drawing books. To this the Principal Suja Ma'am replied that 12 no's of drawing sheets have been given to each students and the work of all the students are displayed on the notice board. This practice of displaying every students art work boost their morale.
- E] Ashwini Ma'am stated that we at City Pride School have introduced age appropriate programs for the allround development of the children. We have GAIT program for classes 1 to 3 which is a customized program conceptualized around the fundamentals of creative movement, this program uses movement as the main language for understanding and expression. She also stated that we have Zoomer program for students across LKG to class 3 which is a multi-sport program for students. It helps to develop the coordination and gross motor skills, building self-confidence and a positive attitude.
- F] Mr. Sharad Anerao stated that the library activities are very useful to the children as it inculcates the habit of reading among the children and goes a long way to improve their verbal skills.
- G] Ashwini ma'am said that parents play a very important role in the competitive exams that the students participate in. City Pride school offers IPM competitive examination for class 3 students. In the future IQube would be introduced to class 4 students and class 6 students will have a robotics lab.
- H] Suja ma'am added that the students have gone for 2 field visits in the first term and they will have one more field visit during the second term. On Saturday, 24th August 2019 the students of class 2 & 3 have a Ganesh idol making competition.
- I] It was also discussed that the school will host the Annual Day program and the Sports Day program alternatively. This year it will be annual day.

Point no 6] Vote of thanks: The meeting adjourned with vote of the thanks by Kiwi Soni. The next meeting was announced to be held in December. Detailed date will be informed through mail.
