#### **Minutes of the Meeting**

**Point 1] : Welcome:-** Principal Mrs. Suja Rajesh welcomed all the members of the Executive PTA for the fourth and last EPTA meeting for year 2019-20.

**Point 2] : Confirmation of previous minutes :** Mrs. Shwetangana Prakash read out the minutes of previous EPTA meeting held on 14 /12/2019

The minutes of meeting were approved by the members unanimously by raising hands.

**Point no. 3] Appointment for new teachers:** The principal Suja Rajesh gave the report of the newly appointed teachers for year 2020 as follows. They will join the school from next academic year.

#### Point 4: Information about next academic year 2020-21

The Principal informed the members that the admission process for academic year 2020-21 is completed successfully. She informed the parents that school will have classes upto standard 5 in year 2020. Following are the details of standards and divisions for academic year 2020. Every division will have 40 students

Standard 1	3 divisions
Standard 2	3 divisions
Standard 3	3 divisions
Standard 4	2 divisions
Standard 5	1 division

She thanked the parents for overwhelming response for admissions to the school.

She informed the members that the final exam will be conducted on. 20<sup>th</sup> March. The timetable is already shared with all the students. The next Academic year will resume on April 5<sup>th</sup> with timings as follows

Primary Section (Class1 & 2) : 8.15 am to 2.30pm

Primary Section (Class3, 4 & 5) : 8.15 am to 3.30pm

School busses will be available from the starting day as per the revised routes for the academic year 2020-21.



### **Point 5] School budget for year 2020-21**

The principal shared the actual income expenditure for year 2019-20 as on today. She informed the parents that the school has been blessed with good infrastructure due to strong support from the trust "Audyogik Tantra Shikshan Sanstha" hence we were able to provide all the facilities to our students. It was possible as the trust even supported for initial cost on equipment like furniture, computers, smart classes etc. over and above the state of art building.

She further informed the parents that considering the increasing requirements of the school and new classes added, the trust has constructed additional 2 floors for academic year 2020-21. The science labs for Physics, Chemistry and Biology will be available from the year 2020-21. She informed the parents that Generator with 85 KW capacity is installed in the campus which can back up the entire school campus. CCTV cameras are also put up at required locations and all classrooms are having audio visual facilities. The school will pay the rent to the trust on building and ground as per the fair market value of Rs. 35 per sq. ft as calculated by the Government certified valuer which was Rs. 38 per sq. ft. The rent will remain same for next 3 years as promised by the trust.

As the parent trust has been supporting us with these facilities, the school did not have financial problems even though the number of students is less. The school pays salaries to teachers as per scale and all the other benefits like PF, gratuity are extended.

Considering all the above, the principal presented the annual budget of the school for year 2020-21. She informed the members that as we have extended the concession to the 2019 admitted batch as discussed in previous meeting, though the fees for year 2020-21 is Rs.71,500/-, the concessional fees of Rs. 65,000/- will continue for 2019 admitted students for one more year, and the same income from fees is considered.

Mrs. Kiwi Soni thanked the school for providing very transparent and fair work culture and also concession for their children in school fees. She added that such practices increase the bond between staff and school.

The members went through the budget sheet. The budget was approved unanimously by all members by raising hands.

**Point 6] Any other points :** Mrs. Rima Nagu shared that as the representative of the parent she has got the feedback that parents are very happy and satisfied with the academic and progress of children in the entire year. Students can converse confidently in English and their reading and writing skills have improved considerably, parents are also very happy with the various activities that are conducted for the students.

Mrs Preeti Kenchangoudar said that the parents were also happy that during the school picnic, PTA class representatives were invited to be a part of the students picnic & witness it one on one.



Mr. Sharad Anerao expressed his happiness about all the facilities being provided by school in terms of infrastructure and transport, he also thanked the school for continuing the concessional fees of Rs.65,000/- for one more year as promised.

He further enquired when the road construction work in front of the school will be completed. Principal Suja Ma'am replied that the work is carried on by the PCMC and we are constantly following up. They have promised that it will be completed withing next 2 months before rains.

**Point 7 ] Vote of thanks:-** Mrs. Kiwi Soni, teacher representative gave the vote of thanks expressing her sincere gratitude to the EPTA members for the parental cooperation throughout the year. She informed that the process of formation of new EPTA will be notified once the next academic year begins.
