MINUTES OF THE MEETING

The PTA Executive body online meeting was called on Saturday, 20th March, 2021 on Microsoft Teams.

Minutes of the Meeting:

Point No. 1 Welcome Note: Mrs. Suja Rajesh, the principal & the chairperson of EPTA extended a warm welcome to all the EPTA members. Principal noted that the requisite quorum for the meeting was present and called the meeting to order.

Point no.2 Confirmation of previous minutes of the meeting: Mrs. Shwetangana. P read out the minutes of previous meeting held on 23-01-2021. The members unanimously confirmed the MOM of the EPTA meeting conducted on 23-01-2021 by raising the hands.

Point no.3 School reopening for academic year 2021-22 : The Principal informed the members that School for the academic year 2021-22 would commence on the 5th of April 2021 and the classes would be conducted online due to the prevailing pandemic situation. She further informed that the timetable of each standard is put up on the top school.

Point no. 4 : Income expenditure 2020-21 and Budget for the academic year 2021-22: The Principal presented the income - expenditure statement for 2020-21 and also the budget for the academic year 2021-22.

While sharing the screen about the budget for the academic year 2021-22, she informed the members that the school has created state of art synthetic sports ground and also proposed to create all three science labs till June 2021. She further informed that the school is also paid full salaries to all staff in 2020 even during pandemic and propose to give due increments to teachers after their annual appraisal. This is essential to retain good teaching staff and keep them motivated for giving best academic performance in teaching. Due to the above decisions by management the school may run in deficit even in year 2021 like that of 2020. but the parents trust Audyogik Tantra Shikshan Sanstha of the school has been kind to support the school in



initial phase so that school will maintain excellent academic standards which is the commitment to the society in general.

The parents appreciated the stand of the parents trust by raising hands.

Mr. Vishal Kulkarni said that the motto of City Pride School "reaching new heights is really coming true". A reputed school like City Pride was much needed in Moshi area and we are happy that our children are admitted in this school. He thanked the school management for starting std. 5 from 2020 so that his child was able to enroll in this school.

Mrs. Kiwi Soni thanked the school management to give salary increments to all teachers even during pandemic times when many others are not even paying full salaries to their staff. On behalf of all teachers, she promised that they will give their best to the school and students.

Point no. 5 : School fee payment schedule for the academic year 2021-22 :

Principal informed the members that though the school fees did not increase and installments are given to parents, many have still not paid the fees for the academic year 2020-21. Though she assured that the school management has been very considerate and have extended additional installment to parents in distress due to pandemic. The school has continues online teaching and evaluation and also will distribute final result report cards to all students whether they have paid fees or not. The school only requests that the parent who are facing financial problem need to submit a written application in this regard so that we can extend help to genuine cases. She further re assured that every teacher, parent or students are the members of City Pride family hence we will take care of all who need help .

As per the request of parents the fees installment schedule has been revised and students can pay in 4 installments in the academic year 2021-22 instead of 3 installments.

The principal added that few parents had requested to give concession in fees for onetime payment, but the school does not believe in giving fee concession to parents who can pay fees at one time as it would be unjust to all those parents who are unable to make the payment of the academic fees even in installments due to financial problems. Though we can relook at this proposal in the next academic year again.

EPTA member Rima Nagu agreed to the point and supported the schools decision regarding the same by raising hands.

Point no 6 : Application for CBSE middle school affiliation:

The principal informed the members that the school will be applying for CBSE affiliation for middle school level . The school will have std.6 in academic year 2021 hence we are eligible for applying for such affiliation. The school has all the required infrastructure as well as qualified



staff for the same. She asked for good wishes of members for successfully going through affiliation process.

Mrs. Manju Sharma, assured that all the staff is trained and motivated, we are sure to succeed in this affiliation process. All the members conveyed their best wishes by raising thumbs up.

Point number 7 : Other points discussed:

I] EPTA member Mrs. Preeti Kenchangoudar pointed out that only 2 hours for the written exams may not be sufficient for the students as they do not have writing practice due to online sessions.

School Response: Suja Ma'am replied that 20 marks questions will be MCQ's and 20 marks written paper. For MCQ's only the correct answer has to be selected and written and it will not take much time to complete as they are one word answers. The remaining 20 marks can be completed within the time remaining and it will not be time consuming and so 2 hrs time is more than enough for the students to write. Exam time will be 9.00 am to 11.30 am [including the uploading time].

II] NEP Implementation: Mrs. Rima Nagu asked when is the National Education Policy expected to be implemented in the schools and if it is possible to arrange for parents webinars for the same.

School Response : Manju Sharma replied that new CBSE syllabus based on NEP 2020 will be implemented only by 2022-23 the system would help with a more seamless and inclusive transition from the lower classes to the higher grades. NEP will pave a way for art integrated learning. Suja Ma'am, also added that webinars have been planned and would be conducted for the parents regarding NEP.

Point no. 8 : Vote of Thanks

Mrs. Kiwi Soni proposed vote of thanks to the members. She informed that this meeting is the last meeting of the present EPTA members. Principal extended her hearty thanks to the EPTA members as they took this responsibility for 2 years consecutively. She assured that whatever decision taken in these 2 years regarding upliftment of school will be rigorously followed by school.

Mr. Sharad Anerao thanked the school on behalf of all parent representatives. He said that the past 2 years were very informative and they enjoyed working on EPTA body because there is complete transparency maintained in all transactions of school.

Mrs. Jyoti Tiwari appreciated that suggestions given by members are implemented by school and hence we feel that we are part of City Pride family.

Mrs. Shwetangana Prakash, thanked the school on behalf of all teacher representatives for great support and learning they got by being EPTA members.

Mrs. Suja Rajesh informed the members that the selection process for new EPTA will start in April immediately after formation of PTA for the academic year 2021-22. The detailed information about the same would be shared on website.
